ATTORNEYS: Numerous attorneys and the court house are located in Wellsboro.

FINANCE: Several banks, credit unions, and financial service companies are available.

FIRE AND AMBULANCE: Wellsboro has a volunteer fire department and EMT-trained ambulance service which is supplemented by the local hospital's paramedic team.

POLICE PROTECTION: A full-time police force serves Wellsboro, and the State Police barracks is located in nearby Mansfield.

SENIOR CENTER: An active group of seniors meet regularly in the Community Center.

TRANSPORTATION: The area is served by two commercial airports; located in Williamsport and Elmira. The Wellsboro Johnston Airport has 3,650' of paved runway. Local bus service is available, as is a charter bus service featuring day and overnight trips.

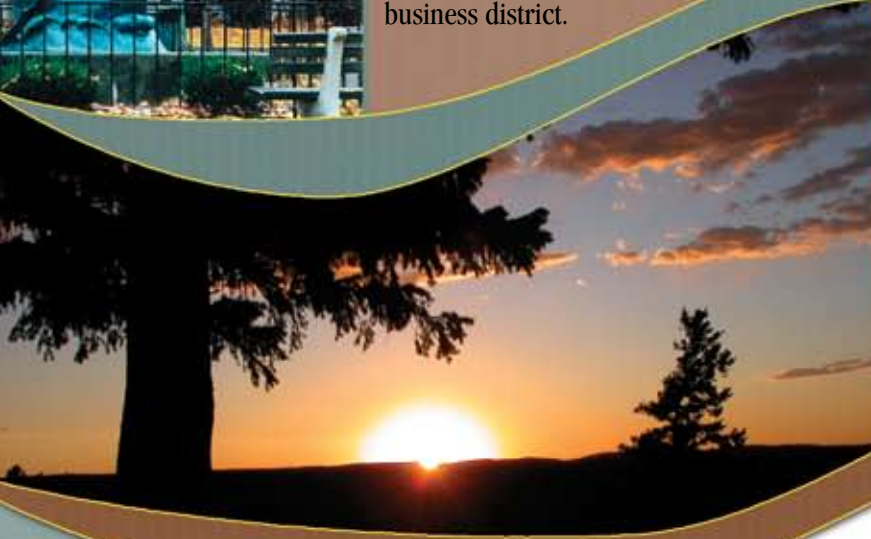
